COVID-19 POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Rocky Mountain Stroke Center (RMSC) is closely following COVID-19 guidelines put into place by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Education. The following policies and procedures are currently in place for all staff, volunteers, and clients participating in in-person/hybrid services with RMSC.

- Masks must be worn when in any RMSC building.
- Proof of full COVID-19 vaccination AND booster vaccination is required to attend in-person/hybrid programming (required to be 2 weeks post-booster vaccination).
- Temperature checks may be performed upon entry into any RMSC building.
- Records of entry may be kept to help RMSC contact appropriate parties if an outbreak were to occur.
- If an individual receiving in-person/hybrid services at RMSC is exposed to COVID-19:
 - The individual must refrain from attending in-person/hybrid programming at RMSC until 7 days post-exposure
 - The individual will be required to provide proof of a negative test result taken no less than 5 days post-exposure.
 - We ask that RMSC be alerted if the individual attended in-person/hybrid programming after the exposure occurred.
- If an individual receiving in-person/hybrid services at RMSC tests positive for COVID-19:
 - The individual must refrain from attending in-person/hybrid programming until 14 days after the positive test result was received.
 - If symptoms persist longer than 14 days, the individual must refrain from attending in-person/hybrid programming until the symptoms have improved/subsided.
 - We ask that RMSC be alerted if the individual has attended in-person/hybrid programming in the 2 weeks prior to positive test result.
